The customer

Ashgate Hospicecare is an independent registered charity that provides specialist palliative and end of life care to adults and their families across North Derbyshire in the UK. The hospice has a 21-bed inpatient unit, 16-place day unit and provides a range of therapy and support services on site. The hospice also provides a wide range of community-based care and support services to enable people to stay in their own homes for as long as possible.

The challenge

Ashgate Hospicecare was faced with an ageing IT infrastructure that had grown organically over the years and was no longer fit for purpose, with performance issues and difficult incident management. The arrival of a new management team provided the necessary spur to re-evaluate its technology needs.

“We have a first class clinical reputation but our IT landscape didn’t reflect it. It had been dictated by cost control rather than business development and that’s something I wanted to change when I came on board,” explains Peter Bradbury, Director of Finance at Ashgate Hospicecare. “This is a sizeable organisation, responsible for the care of many patients, and I wanted to have an underlying IT framework that would support the good work we do.”

Ashgate Hospicecare turned to local technology consultants, AAG Systems, one of the UK’s fastest growing IT providers, which provides a broad range of IT related services including hardware and software supply and managed services.
