New Backup Solution and Multi-Layered Security Concept

The Wernsing Food Family, a company with a strong tradition, has built its success on continually exploring innovative approaches. To modernize its IT infrastructure and meet the demands of a contemporary Industry 4.0 production environment, the group partnered with Fujitsu for expert guidance and implementation. Through this tech transformation, the IT infrastructure was comprehensively upgraded, delivering greater efficiency, security, and flexibility in an increasingly digitalized production landscape.

Key initiatives included the design and deployment of a new backup environment based on Veeam, along with the implementation of a multi-layered security strategy to fully isolate the backup environment. This included role-based Privileged Identity Management (PIM) for dynamic administration of access rights and a complete network segmentation between backup, production, and other operational areas.

The backup solution integrates a Linux-based backup-to-disk (immutable) with a backup-totape system and is supported by ongoing remote operational support and regular health checks for Veeam, Linux, and the SAN infrastructure. Licensing was standardized via Veeam Enterprise Manager, enabling comprehensive protection for HyperV, VMware, databases, and additional applications.

Fail-Safe Environment with ETERNUS and PRIMERGYY

The Wernsing Food Family relies entirely on Microsoft Hyper-V and has built a fail-safe environment using ETERNUS and PRIMERGY systems. At the core is the ETERNUS AF250 S3 StorageCluster, which provides high-availability all-flash capacity of around 170 TB net and enables transparent failover through synchronous mirroring. Various Microsoft Hyper-V and SQL clusters access the storage over the FibreChannel SAN network, distributed across 12 PRIMERGY RX2540 servers and additional specialized systems for SQL, Business Intelligence, and VEEAM Proxy. These systems are symmetrically distributed across two data centers, with a third location dedicated to backup and management, also integrated into the SAN. This location houses additional PRIMERGY servers and ETERNUS systems responsible for backup mirroring and management.
